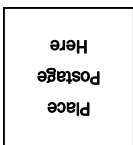

VIRGINIA WATER CONFERENCE 2010

It's time to prepare for the VLWA Conference. The conference will again be held at the *Holiday Inn Select Koger Conference Center* in Richmond, Virginia, where we have hosted more than 200 participants at each of the last few conferences. We expect strong attendance from Federal, State, and local agency employees, lake owners & operators, consultants, product vendors, etc. Breakout sessions will feature many worthwhile professional papers from every sector of the Virginia water community.

PRESENTING AT THE CONFERENCE

If you would like to present your work to an interesting mixture of people, here is the opportunity. Working with the *Virginia Floodplain Management Association (VFMA)*, our Association addresses lakes and watersheds, engineering and life sciences, facilities, maintenance, public works, consulting, academic research, and administration. We serve a challenging variety of people all working to improve Virginia's lakes and watersheds.

Presentations are selected based on abstract summaries of up to two pages which will be published in the conference proceedings. Appropriate topics include research and practical applications in stormwater management, watershed management, hydrology, hydraulics, limnology, water quality, biology, dam safety, dam and lake maintenance, and related water subjects. Presentations are logically grouped in the program. Upon acceptance, we will contact you as to your place on the schedule. This year, we are advancing the deadline for abstract submission to finalize the program earlier and give opportunities to a wider audience for participation. We will make every effort to keep to the following schedule:

Abstract Submission: November 20, 2009
Acceptance Notification: January 15, 2010
Program Publication: February 3, 2010

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Submit abstracts in Microsoft Word™ format. Use letter-sized format with one-inch margins all around and at least 10-point typeface with a maximum of two such pages. Abstracts must include the presentation title as well as the names, organizations, addresses, and phone numbers of all authors. Separately, submit a brief biographical sketch for each speaker suitable for a 20- to 30-second introduction. Include name, organization, position, college or university, and related interests. Submit paper and electronic copies of the abstract and biographical sketch.
